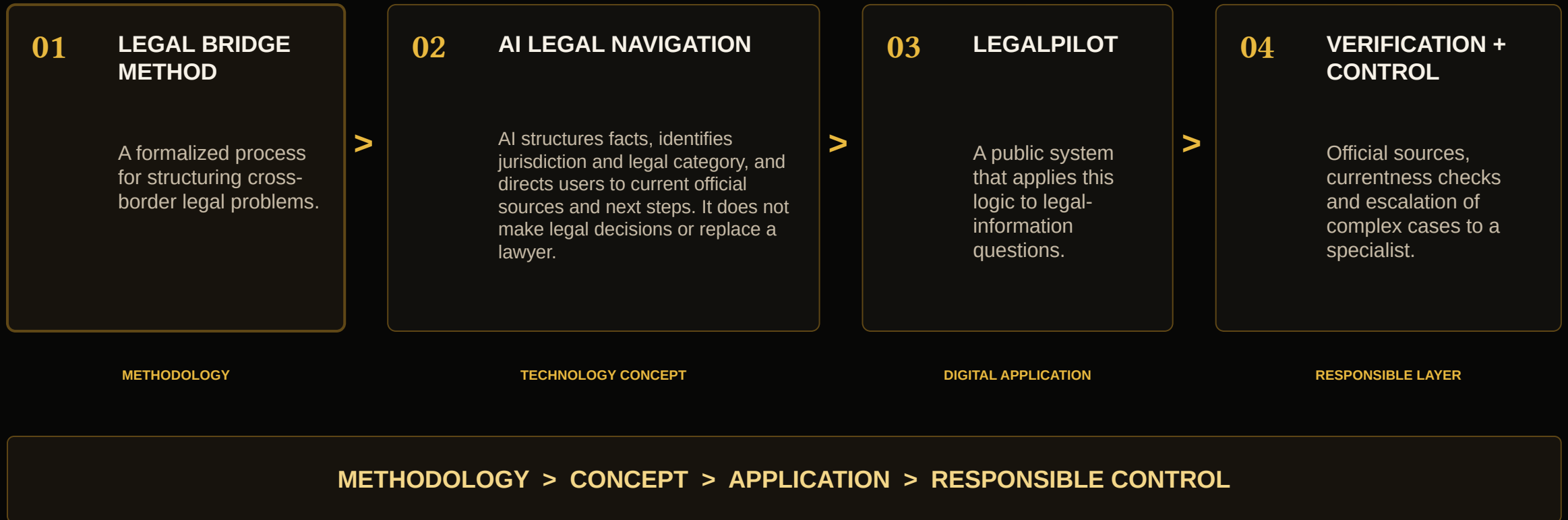

A proprietary methodology becomes a verifiable legal-navigation system

The intellectual contribution is not a single chatbot answer, but an architecture that connects four layers.



The problem is legal fragmentation, not a lack of information

One life situation may be governed by several systems, each defining status, rights, duties, deadlines and procedures differently.

INTERNATIONAL

treaties / human-rights standards

NATIONAL

migration / civil / administrative law

LOCAL

regional rules / procedures / institutions

METHODOLOGICAL RESPONSE

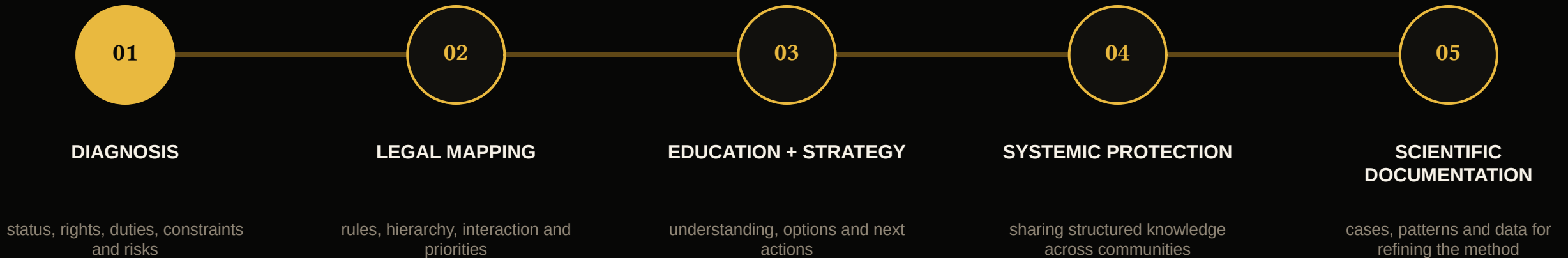
Build a unified legal profile

- identify the person and context
- identify the applicable jurisdictions
- connect rules with official sources
- explain the practical implications

The method preserves differences between legal systems while making their interaction understandable.

Five defined stages turn a legal situation into structured knowledge

The stages are sequential: each result becomes the basis for the next.



A reproducible analytical sequence, not a one-off generated answer

A person's situation becomes a verifiable legal-navigation path

Each step reduces uncertainty and shows the basis for the next action.



How is the system different from a standard chatbot?

Eight requirements govern how legal information is organized, verified and bounded.

01 JURISDICTION AWARENESS

Different countries and regions may require different legal paths.

02 CONTEXT ANALYSIS

The user's situation is structured before a final response is produced.

03 OFFICIAL SOURCES

Government and other authoritative sources take priority.

04 TEMPORAL VALIDITY

Current fees, dates, forms and procedures must be verified.

05 PRACTICAL STEPS

The result focuses on what the user can verify or do next.

06 DOCUMENT FOCUS

Forms, evidence and procedural requirements are identified explicitly.

07 RISK ESCALATION

Individual and high-risk questions receive more cautious handling.

08 HUMAN OVERSIGHT

When information is insufficient, the need for qualified help is stated.

AI structures navigation but does not make legal decisions

This boundary is part of the system architecture, not a fine-print disclaimer.

AI DOES

- structures facts and context
- identifies applicable jurisdictions
- guides users to official sources
- shows practical next steps
- signals when a specialist is needed

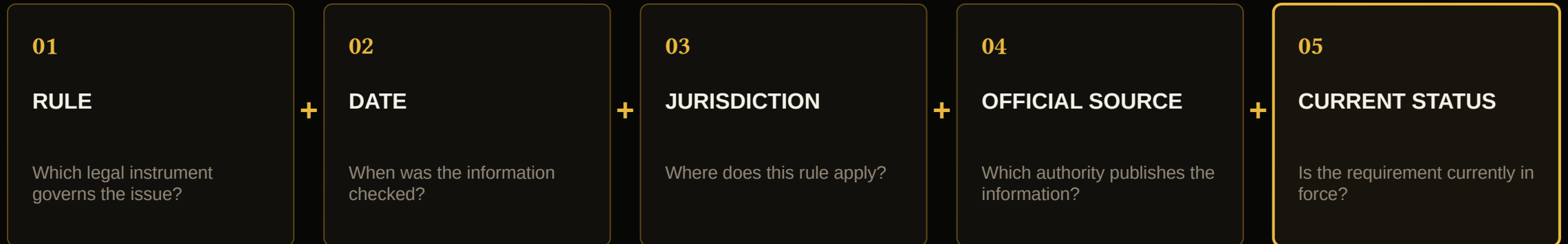
AI DOES NOT

- ✗ does not act as the user's lawyer
- ✗ does not become a source of law
- ✗ does not guarantee an entitlement or outcome
- ✗ does not replace an individualized legal decision
- ✗ does not retain claims without a reliable source

The question is escalated to a person when it becomes individualized, factually complex, high-risk or legally significant.

Legal information is useful only when its current status is clear

Laws, fees, forms, deadlines and procedures change. Currentness is therefore treated as an essential quality of legal information.

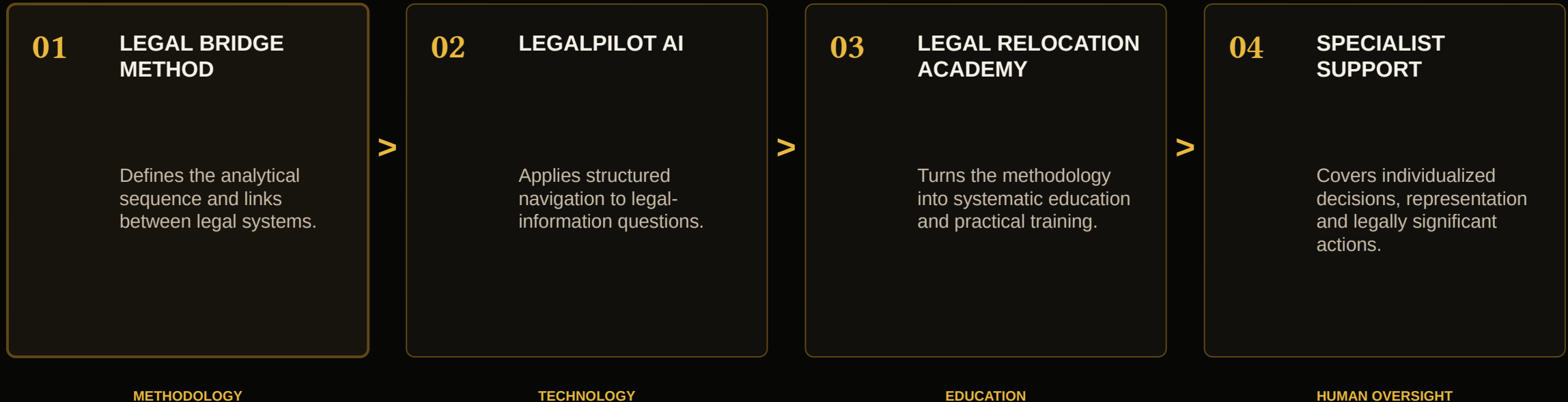


IMPLEMENTED CONTROL

Precise current values must have an official source or a transparent verification caveat; stale or weakly supported claims are sent back for revision.

One methodology connects technology, education and specialist support

The initial audience is Ukrainians abroad. The architecture is designed for cross-border legal navigation.
